The Scholarship is to offset costs in traditional college and trade school programs including but not limited to: Human Resources; Labor Relations; Arbitration; Collective Bargaining; Investigation; Counseling; and Public Relations.

Eligibility Requirements:

Any full active member of UFCW Local 555 in good standing for at least one (1) year prior to the application deadline (May 5, 2022) is eligible to apply. A member may also sponsor their child, grandchild, or spouse.

A scholarship application, *official* high school and/or *official* college transcripts, an essay of up to 500 words, a picture (preferred but optional—to be used in publications), and three (3) letters of recommendation must be received by May 5, 2022 and sent to the Northwest Hope Foundation. Anything submitted in excess of the above will not be considered. All materials will be judged by the Scholarship Committee. *Only* the winners will be notified, and their pictures may be published in the UFCW Local 555 Newsletter.
